

## Conditions of Play

Name:	<b>CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS</b>
Event	<b>STROKE – Club Championships 2018</b>
Conditions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>MEN</b> – open to players with 6 or 7-day membership.</li> <li>2. <b>WOMEN</b> – open to players with 6 or 7-day membership.</li> <li>3. <b>SENIORS</b> – open to players with 5/6/7-day membership 65 plus years</li> <li>4. <b>JUNIORS</b> – open to all players under 18 years (must be 17 years old when playing the first round)</li> <li>5. Maximum Daily Handicap for Men 36 and Women 45.</li> <li>6. A player's club daily handicap at the time of playing the 1<sup>st</sup> round for this event will remain until the event is completed for overall categories.</li> <li>7. The Club Championship Entry Form shall be completed and submitted to the golf shop prior to 5pm Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> November. To be eligible for the overall Board Events a player <u>must</u> pay their entry fee (\$60 or \$45) in full before hitting their first shot in round 1.</li> <li>8. A fee of \$60 will be paid prior to the commencement of the first round for the Men and Juniors, and \$45 for the Women and Seniors.</li> <li>9. Reduced Saturday Green fees are payable by all Male 6-day members who play on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rounds. Green Fee will be \$30. This will not apply to the Women's first round or any Senior's round.</li> <li>10. Members who cannot play all rounds of their events are able to enter the 'Daily competition' of each day at a cost of \$15. These players will be allocated tee times outside of the overall championship entrants.</li> <li>11. The Match and Green Committee shall decide the groupings for each round of the Championship. Players <u>must play</u> within the allocated times for their grades for example A Grade all play in PM times on Day 1 and AM on Day 2 etc.</li> <li>12. The third round will be seeded according to the 36-hole gross scores per Grade (A/B/C) and the final day will be re-drawn for each Grade based on their 54-hole gross scores.</li> <li>13. Championship Grades will be set based on a player's Daily Handicap as of the first round. (A Grade + - 8) (B Grade 9 -18) (C Grade 19 -36) (Women &amp; Seniors – Open).</li> <li>14. All Men's Grades and Juniors (Boys and Girls) are played over 72 holes – Tournament Tees. Junior Boys will play off the Men's Tournament Tees, and Girls will play off the Women's Tournament Pink Tees. Junior Boys are also eligible for their Grades.</li> <li>15. Seniors played over 54 holes from the Gold tees (not eligible for any Grade events/prizes).</li> <li>16. The Women's Championship will be played over 54 holes – Women's Tournament Pink Tees. Junior Girls are eligible for Women's Championship, with their scores for the equivalent three rounds counting for the overall Women's event.</li> </ol>

	<p>17. The lowest (GROSS) score in each Grade shall be that respective Grade Champion and the overall lowest 72-hole Gross score will be the Club Champion winner across all Grades.</p> <p>18. The lowest (NETT) score in each Grade shall be that respective Grade Nett Champion and <b>the overall lowest 72-hole Nett score will be the Captain's Trophy winner (across all Grades, not Seniors)</b>. The lowest Women's or Junior Girls Nett score over 54 Holes will be the Women's Captain's Trophy winner.</p> <p>19. Groups will be drawn by the M&amp;G Committee and players must play in their allotted Grades. Once the draw has been completed no alterations will be made (unless approved by the Captain)</p> <p>20. Use of motorised golf carts is permitted. Players wishing to be eligible to win the overall Club Championship i.e.: Open Gross <u>will not be permitted to use a cart in any rounds</u> (unless a recent medical certificate is produced).</p> <p>21. In the event of a tie in the Gross event in each Grade and Women's, Juniors and Seniors, a sudden death playoff will take place by repeating the 18<sup>th</sup> hole until there is a winner.</p> <p>22. Where, after the completion of the above events, two or more players are equal in lowest total <u>Nett</u> score, the count-back system will be used to decide the winner on the final day's 18-hole card, and the final 9 holes.</p> <p>23. All players are required to have registered with the Golf Shop no later than 10 minutes prior to their tee time. Players registering after this time will be subject to a 2 shot penalty. Any player registering on or after their tee time will be disqualified.</p> <p>24. No practice is permitted on course on the day of play, or after the Saturday round on both weekends.</p> <p>25. The Club's Pace of Play 'Ready Golf' policy will be enforced including penalties for any player or group that is deemed by the course marshal to be out of position. Play 'Ready Golf' and if in doubt hit a provisional.</p> <p>26. All disputes are to be submitted in writing directly to the Club Captain (or Golf Shop), addressed to the Club Captain within 15 minutes of the final players finishing their round on the day of the dispute. The dispute will be heard by attending members of the Match &amp; Green Committee whose decision shall be final.</p> <p>27. The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&amp;A Rules Limited, together with such local rules as are in force on the day of play.</p> <p>28. Professional golfers are permitted to win the daily but not the Championship events.</p>
