



CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE



Dear Members,

As Autumn sets in and we start to feel the change of the seasons the team have undertaken the last renovation during this year's growing season. This major renovation will help us get the greens back to their previously smooth surface before it cools down.

All across the club, the team have been working hard across the summer to continue to manage our financial position during key water usage months. I am pleased to advise that we continue to trade in the black for this financial year as we head into the last three months we are starting to invest again in areas that you have provided feedback.

Starters Hut and Drinks Cart

The board and management team have been reviewing the starters hut and drinks cart services in line with our goal to deliver a great member experience. These services have been contracted to a third party and as part of this review, the provider of these services will change effective from the 5th of April. This change in providers is aimed at ensuring we are focused on the member's experience. In order to make this change, we have needed to compromise on what is available to be provided. This is due to an existing lease with Sanctuary Lakes Function Centre where alcohol is provided under their liquor license. This will mean that until further notice the Drinks Cart or Starters Hut will not serve alcohol or coffee. If you do want to drink on the course, you will need to buy alcoholic drinks from the Norman Room. Please note that our course is not licensed for BYO.

We believe that this change in provider will be positive and urge all members to try out the new provider.

Men's Showers

Due to our improved financial position, the board have also resolved to replace the shower dividers in the men's change rooms. This will remove the old water damaged dividers, bring the showers up to a standard that we expect to be providing for our members.

Lastly as promised, the team have been working through our strategic plan for the next 3-5 years. This plan will be published to members in May provides a clear roadmap on an exciting future for the club and its members.
