Course Update 2

Welcome rain continues to fall to bring in winter, with Mark and his crew continuing to work through a number of tasks throughout the course.

Recently, the overgrown reeds and weed around the dams and waterways have been cut back, and unsightly chains and poles have been removed.

Top dressing has been applied to the end of cart paths to alleviate the bumpy ride that greet golfers as the head towards the fairway. Generally, there is no need to avoid these areas if you are in a cart, as we want the carts to assist in the compaction of the soil. The exception, is of course if the area becomes muddy, or has been roped off for reseeding (5th and 14th)

Driving Range Closed

The Driving Range will be closed until mid-day next Thursday 6th of June for the Range Upgrade.

We will be installing support poles for new and raised targets, as well as adding brackets to house the new lighting system. We are hopeful dividers for the new hitting bays are delivered which will allow this area to be opened for use.
