Course Update

The wet weather may have slowed our progress on the course works, but it's still all happening...

The Northern side of the 3rd creek has been mounded and the excess dirt has been pushed back into the wider rough (see below). This will be allowed to dry out and will be top-dressed and seeded towards the end of winter.

Next week we will be excavating under the bridge and installing pipework to join the two bodies of water. The temporary access bridge (pictured below) will be in place for next week. Directional signage will be in place where necessary.

The excavation works around the 8th dam have been completed. Excess soil has been relocated to the left hand side of the fairway. The exposed areas will be top dressed and seeded where required.



The trucks continue to deliver soil to the driving range with the amphitheatre effect coming along nicely. These framing mounds will be compacted and seeded upon completion.

All of these works result in no outlay to the Club. A contra arrangement for the soil disposal, in return for all the heavy equipment and man power required on site are expected to provide ongoing savings in the form of increased water storage. We expect to increase storage by approximately 10 meg upon completion of these winter works, or say \$25k each time these dams are filled!

Errant Shot Register
