Course Update

The excavation along the 3rd creek has continued this week, with the edges of the creek cambered down into the water's edge. The top metre or so of the exposed soil will be sod (rolled grass) in the coming weeks (weather dependent).

The meeting of the two bodies of water, being the 4th dam and 3rd creek, could take place by mid next week. Underneath the bridge we need to join our irrigation pipe, following which we will dig out adjacent to the pipes under the bridge in the 4th dam, which will allow stored water to be transported up the third creek.
